Subject: NRC Requested Changes to the Fermi 2 Physical Security Plan, Safeguards Contingency Plan, and Security Training and Qualification Plan

The NRC issued an Order dated April 29, 2003, requiring compliance with the revised design basis threat (Reference 2). Detroit Edison responded by submitting a completely revised Physical Security Plan, Safeguards Contingency Plan, and Security Training and Qualification Plan for Fermi Unit 2 that followed the outline of Nuclear Energy Institute (NEI) 03-012. The NRC subsequently asked that the plans be revised through four requests for additional information. Detroit Edison responded to each request separately, and ultimately submitted revised plans in Reference 3.


