## Subject: DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY PROGRAM

Dear Mr. Ziegler:

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) is conducting a Science and Technology (S&T) program that aims to investigate a wide range of topics related to the potential repository at Yucca Mountain, Nevada. Although DOE has stated that the S&T program will be conducted separately from the repository program and that information from the S&T program will not be used in a possible license application, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) has a regulatory interest in the program.

Our interest in the S&T program is grounded in 10 CFR Part 63. 10 CFR 63.21 requires that any license application for a geologic repository operations area must describe any plans or programs for developing additional information related to that repository. Such information may include research and development programs to resolve safety questions, confirm the adequacy of design, conduct various tests and experiments, and the overall program of performance confirmation. Timely information on the DOE S&T program would ensure that NRC is aware of emerging issues and potential changes, and allow NRC to provide guidance to DOE (e.g., about quality assurance standards for any DOE S&T work). This would support our safety role and inform NRC staff activities in evaluating an application for a construction authorization, license to receive and possess, or any amendments to a construction authorization or license, if issued.

As a starting point in our interaction on this important subject, please provide information on the process for determining what elements of the S&T program could influence repository design, construction, operations, or performance; and the mechanism for transferring information from the S&T program to the repository program. We would also appreciate being placed on the
