 - radioactivity measurements standardization and monitoring techniques and instruments;
 - c. mathematics and calculations basic to the use and measurement of radioactivity; and
 - d. biological effects of radiation.

In addition, describe the specific isotopes the individual has handled, the maximum quantities of materials handled, where the experience was gained, the duration of the experience and the type of use, or:

2. If the uses on the University of Texas license are essentially similar to the uses on this license, you may submit a copy of the University of Texas license or the license number for our review.
