Subject: Amendment to Materials License No. 50-27740-01

To Whom It May Concern,

ASRC Energy Services Inspection, Inc. is proposing to move the permanent storage vault from its present location.

The present vault is located inside the Fabrication Shop. With the possibility of increased production during the winter months it is felt that the General Public would be better served if the vault was relocated.

An 8' by 20' metal shipping container would be utilized for securing inner lead lined vaults. The conex has outer and inner lockable doors which are controlled by the RSO. The inside will be lined with lead sheeting. (See attached drawing)

The conex will be located approximately 300' from the Fabrication Shop. This area is inside a fenced perimeter that opens onto Cook Inlet. The surrounding area is patrolled 24/7 by a security company. (See attached drawing).

Does this scenario meet with NRC regulations? If so, may we have permission to proceed?


