The hearing request was submitted in response to a notice that the NRC staff is reviewing a proposed amendment to the license of the Safety Light Corporation (Docket Nos. 30-5980 and 30-5982) that would renew Safety Light's operating license for its activities conducted at its Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania facility and authorize decommissioning of contaminated portions of that facility. The notice was published in the Federal Register at 69 Fed. Reg. 39515 (June 30, 2004)
