The planes that destroyed the World Trade Center buildings on September 11, 2001 flew over the Indian River Nuclear facility (25 miles outside of NYC) on their way to the Trade Center. Indian River could just as easily have been the target that day, which would have resulted in a radioactive catastrophe that would have dwarfed what happened to the Trade Center. Both the International Atomic Energy Agency and the NRC itself have admitted that plant containment structures were not built to withstand attacks from airliners such as those used by Osama Bin Laden's followers on September 11, 2001.
