The purpose of this modification is to:

1. Revise paragraph (b) of Section C.4, PERSONNEL QUALIFICATIONS, to include additional engineering disciplines.

Accordingly, this contract is modified as follows:

1. Section C.4, PERSONNEL QUALIFICATIONS is DELETED entirely and REPLACED with the following:

"C4. PERSONNEL QUALIFICATIONS

(a) Personnel shall have an engineering degree and/or equivalent technical experience with respect to theories, principles and practices of NRC licensed commercial power reactor plants.

(b) Personnel shall also have experience in disciplines related to design, installation and operation of power reactor plants. Such disciplines include, but are not limited to, mechanical systems, electrical power systems, instrumentation and control systems, mechanical components, civil/structural engineering, integrated plant operations, and fire protection engineering.

c) Experience shall include: (1) performing design inspections, (2) design of commercial U.S. power reactor plants (e.g., based on employment at architectural/engineering firms or NSSS suppliers), and (3) understanding of NRC's Regulatory Oversight Process and regulatory requirements for power reactor plant design and operation."

All other terms and conditions remain the same.
