By letter dated October 19, 2004, Mr. J. E. Dyer, Director of the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation, acknowledged your August 10, 2004, petition filed pursuant to Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations*, Section 2.206 (10 CFR 2.206). Among other things, the letter informed you that the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff will take action on your petition within a reasonable time.

I called you on November 22, 2004, to inform you of the status of the NRC's action. I told you that the NRC staff had determined that the issues in your petition are similar to issues that are the subject of a report being prepared by the National Academy of Sciences (NAS). Accordingly, the NRC staff's response to the petition will be prepared in parallel with the NRC's response to the NAS report. NAS expects to issue a publicly available version of its report by December 31, 2004.
