I am working independently, but in conjunction with the University Of Texas Southwestern Medical Center (UTSWMC) in Dallas, to determine the need for a enterprise web-based tracking system for inventory, usage and disposal of radioactive materials in a research environment. It is our hope that the tracking system will allow both small and large institutions, academic and industrial having either specific or broad scope radiation licenses, to have a single centralized interface to register then track decay / disposal radioactive material usage and manage instrument calibration and personnel records.



- Number of Specific licenses issued to (a) Academic (b) Industrial and (c) Medical/hospital institutions (d) Research and Development
- Number of BroadScope licenses issued to (a) Academic (b) Industrial and (c) Medical/hospital institutions (d) Research and Development
- Total number of Specific licenses and total number of General licenses
- If available, number of compliance violations, including type of violation in (a) Academic (b) Industrial and (c) medical/hospital institutions (d) Research and Development

The information, along with statistics collected from individual US states, will form the basis of our assessment as to whether we should continue to pursue the development of this software platform.
