**Subject:** Ecology Services Final Status Survey report -

11/10 left messages with Neese, Rasmianfar regarding a problem with the report, submitted as "Proprietary Information". The left voice mail 11/11 and 11/12. I spoke with each one on 11/15/04. (I had spoken with Ecology Services, who provided me with a the information that Razmianfar was the person they worked with, and gave me a telephone number for him.)

Michael Neese works in administration. I explained the issue of the "proprietary information" and that the NRC has specific criteria for what information may be considered proprietary, and how to request that such information be withheld. Mr. Nees stated that he will fax a letter to the region 1 office that states that the information is NOT proprietary as defined in 2.390. When we get that letter, we can go ahead and process the October 28 letter with the report.

Nasser Razmianfar is the technical contact for this action. He explained that the natural uranium canisters were actually removed about a year ago, but that some contamination was identified on them. Therefore, they had the room decommissioned and surveyed. Ecology Services performed the survey and provided that report.
