Dear Mr. Ragland:

This letter is a follow up to our telephone conversation of Tuesday, November 9, 2004 regarding the mobile PET coach owned by PET of America. At that time, there were 3 issues that you wanted clarification. Please allow the following paragraphs to assist.

1. The mobile coach is locked at all times unless the technical staff is present and working within the coach. It is locked in the event that they leave during working hours to go to lunch or enter the hospital they are servicing.
2. The keys will be given to the driver of the tractor, lead technologist, and supplier of radioactive materials (radiopharmacy).
