<p>Subject: On 11/09/04 Dr. Borys R. Krynyckyi, responded by telephone to an e-mail from R. Ragland regarding whether or not Personal Care Molecular Imaging had secured a permanent location for their proposed licensed activities as described in their 8/30/04 application. Dr. Krynyckyi stated that they were unable to secure Autumn Ridge Building 1, Suite 114, 3350 Route 138, Wall Township, NJ 07719 for their proposed licensed activities. Dr. Krynyckyi confirmed that he is actively seeking an alternate location to conduct proposed licensed activities. On 11/10/04, I informed Dr. Krynyckyi that NRC had performed the majority of the review for the license application including administrative processing, performance of the technical review, and generation of a draft copy of the letter and license. I stated that if this action is voided, then he would lose his application fee and would have to resubmit a new license application. However, I informed Dr. Krynyckyi that if he was able to secure a location for proposed licensed activities and submit a revised license application with sufficient time for NRC to process the license application prior to November 29, 2004, then NRC could accommodate that review without requiring an additional submission of an application fee. I informed him that he would need to request an expedited review.</p>
