SUBJECT: PORTSMOUTH GASEOUS DIFFUSION PLANT - REVISION TO
IMPLEMENTATION OF INTERIM COMPENSATORY ORDER

Dear Mr. Brown:

In accordance with your application dated August 24, 2004, and pursuant to Part 76 to Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations, your request to modify the methods used to implement the Interim Compensatory Measures (ICMs) required by U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) order dated June 17, 2002, at the Portsmouth Gaseous Diffusion Plant, is hereby approved.

The NRC staff has reviewed the request by the United States Enrichment Corporation (USEC) to allow public access to portions of Perimeter Road that surround the Portsmouth Gaseous Diffusion Plant operated by USEC near Piketon, Ohio. The NRC staff found that the proposed security changes to allow the opening of portions of Perimeter Road are acceptable, and are in accordance with current regulatory requirements and the NRC's June 17, 2002, Interim Compensatory Measure Order for the Portsmouth site.

The details of USEC's request, and the basis for NRC's approval, are classified and not available for public review.
