<p>Summary:</p> <p>The licensee requested to increase possession limit of I-131 from 100 millicuries to 2 curies. I reviewed the licensee's procedures for using I-131 and did not find details of measuring thyroid uptakes (instrumentation, etc.) . I called the RSO to discuss these items and to determine if all 2 curies of I-131 will be used at one time.</p> <p>He told me that they do not measure uptake themselves, but send their workers to a nearby nuclear medicine laboratory or hospital for these measurements. Similarly, urine bioassays are analyzed by an independent laboratory. He also stated that the material will be used over several days in closed systems.</p> <p>I requested that he provide this information in writing. He promised to send the requested information as soon as possible.</p>
