I am an attorney for the Blue Ridge Environmental Defense League, which has intervened in a license amendment case involving the Catawba nuclear power plant. On Tuesday, December 7, I am scheduled to take a

deposition of a Duke Energy Corporation employee at the Catawba plant. I have arranged with Neal Gross and Co. to have court reporter Edward Johns make a transcript of the deposition.
