In a letter dated September 30, 2004, the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) submitted a revised report titled "Key Technical Issue Letter Report (Response to GEN 1.01), Revision 2," to satisfy the informational needs of General (GEN) Agreement GEN.1.01. The GEN.1.01 agreement contains 49 specific comments addressing topics and informational needs pertaining to numerous Key Technical Issue (KTI) agreements. The information was requested by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) during a technical exchange in September 2001.
