I informed him that the information that would be required could be found in NUREG-1556, Volume 7. He stated that he was unsure whether he had a copy and requested that I send one to him. He asked what was meant by a complete application and an abbreviated one. I replied that a complete application covers all of the areas as outlined in the NUREG and an abbreviated application covers only those areas which have changed and the licensee may refer the reviewer to those documents which were previously submitted for information about the program that has not changed. Mr. Cammerata stated that he would call me if he had any further questions and would see to it that the application was received prior to December 31, 2004.</p>
