SUBJECT: ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF REQUEST FOR LICENSE AMENDMENT TO REVISE  
THE LICENSE TERMINATION PLAN FOR THE HADDAM NECK PLANT

Dear Mr. Norton:

The NRC staff has received your application for license amendment dated December 1, 2004, CY-04-131, for the Haddam Neck Plant. Your letter requests use of a revised buried debris dose model and revised surface contamination release limits for various sizes of buried pipe.

We have completed the initial processing, which is an administrative review, and have accepted your application for a more detailed technical review. The more detailed technical review may identify omissions in the submitted information or technical issues that will result in a Request for Additional Information (RAI). If required, these will be forwarded to you under separate cover. The staff expects to complete its review by May, 2005. This schedule assumes no RAIs are required.
