**Subject:** NRC's review of USEC Inc.'s gas centrifuge license application

The purpose of this e-mail is to inform you of completion of a milestone and to provide you other information that you may be interested in related to the subject project.

NRC's acceptance of application for review

Last Thursday (October 7), the NRC accepted for detailed technical review USEC Inc.'s (USEC's) application to construct and operate in Piketon OH a 3.5 million separative work unit (SWU) per year gas centrifuge uranium enrichment plant also known as the American Centrifuge Plant (ACP). In its license application submitted on August 23, 2004, USEC has requested the NRC to grant it authorization to enrich uranium at the ACP up to 10 percent in the fissile U-235 isotope. The NRC anticipates completing its safety, security and environmental reviews by February 2006.

License application documents
