On March 3, 2004, the staff received a letter from Congressmen Dingell and Markey questioning the staff's intentions with regards to fire protection operator manual actions. I hope by now everyone has seen the letter, if not please let me know and I'll get you a copy. The Congressmen seemed to be concerned with their perception that the ongoing rulemaking for 10 CFR 50, Appendix R, III.G.2 is a weakening of the regulations.

They have asked almost twenty questions with most questions containing multiple related questions.
