In the above referenced letter, you requested an extension of the period for receipt of comments for consideration on the Fuel Cycle Safety and Safeguards (FCSS) draft Interim Staff Guidance (ISG) -10, Minimum Margin of Subcriticality for Safety, from the January 5, 2005, date stated in the December 6, 2004, Federal Register notice to February 7, 2005. This letter is to inform you that the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) FCSS will consider all comments made on the draft ISG through February 7, 2005.

We appreciate your planned comments to draft ISG-10, which is intended to provide licensing review guidance for fuel cycle facilities licensed under 10 CFR 70. This subject is also expected to be discussed at an open NRC meeting with industry, an integrated safety analysis workshop, which is tentatively scheduled for February 22, 2005, in Rockville, Maryland.
