Dear Mr. Irani:

By letter dated September 24, 2004, you provided notification to this office that you would initiate certain activities under the subject license, in 10 days. License Condition 13 requires at least 14 day written notification prior to initiating activities at <u>each</u> temporary job site, excluding routine packaging or repackaging for purposes of transporting and jobs not requiring a site specific work package, or characterization and/or final surveys where radioactive materials and/or radiation are not likely to be detected. Nonetheless, due to the time-critical nature of the work being performed for the U.S. Navy at the Marine Corps Logistics Base, Albany, Georgia, the staff accepts and considers your notification as timely.

Please note that this should not be construed as a general waiver of the requirements under your license, as this office expects licensees to be in compliance with all license conditions.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter and its enclosure will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the NRC document system (ADAMS). ADAMS is accessible from the NRC Web site at http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html.

Please note that on October 25, 2004, the NRC suspended public access to ADAMS, and initiated an additional security review of publicly available documents to ensure that potentially sensitive information is removed from public accessibility in the ADAMS database through the NRC's web site.
