Here is my comment:
Comment to NRC regarding Committee to Bridge the Gap Petition

I live within a mile of the Pilgrim NPP in Plymouth, Mass. and I have been horrified at the vulnerability of the plant to a terrorist attack. I am speaking particularly about the spent fuel rods which are housed in a separate building from the reactor, very high off the ground level and protected by only a thin metal roof. The so-called "no-fly zone" around the plant is no longer patrolled by US aircraft, and the US Coast Guard patrols perhaps once a month in the area. It is absolutely essential that some form of physical security be added such as "Beamhenge" barriers to protect against attack by a explosive loaded small aircraft.

Having worked for Physicians for Social Responsibility, I am familiar with the effects of radiation on human tissue, both short term and long term, and I am appalled at the lack of protection now afforded the public around nuclear power plants, in the event of a "dirty bomb" type of attack.
