Dear Ms. Dolce,

As per our telephone conversation on February 22, 1996 requesting additional information regarding the above referenced amendment request, I have addressed your concerns below. For ease of review, your statements/concerns have been restated and are followed by our response.

1. Confirm that the I-125 seeds come from a manufacturer licensed under 10 CFR 32.74 or equivalent.

We confirm that these sources will be obtained from a manufacturer authorized to distribute them in accordance with a specific license issued pursuant to 32.74 of 10 CFR 32 or under equivalent regulations of an agreement state.

2. How will you satisfy labeling requirements under 10 CFR 32.74(a)(2 viii) ?

Reference to the package insert will be made on the prescription label under special instructions. Specifically it will state: "Storage & Handling - see Pkg Insert". The package insert provides information on the handling and storing of the sealed sources from the "radiation safety" standpoint.

3. Confirm that the package insert will be sent to the customer.

The manufacturer's package insert will accompany all transfers of I-125 seeds to authorized recipients.

4. How will you differentiate between different source strengths?

Sources of specified strengths are received in labeled containers from the manufacturer. The seeds are transferred from these containers into magazines per physician prescription. A map of the magazine is supplied to the customer showing the number and source

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strength of the seeds in each cartridge in the magazine.

5. Confirm that the I-125 seeds will not be "tampered" with.

We confirm that I-125 seeds will not be "tampered" with at the pharmacy.
