PROGRAM SCOPE

Small Industrial Radiography Licensee. The President of the company is the RSO and sole user. There are 3 assistants. Licensee possesses one Spec 150 camera. Usage was approximately 46 times during 2004. License authorizes storage in Anchorage and a field station in Fairbanks, but use is mainly in Fairbanks. The licensee is also authorized portable gauges under a different license which are stored and used in Anchorage. All documentation was in order. Last inspection was December 2003 and was clear. This inspection resulted in no violations and a clear 591M was issued on site.
