This letter and the enclosed NRC Form 591M refer to the inspection conducted on November 18, 2004, at a temporary jobsite on Hickam Air Force Base. This inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to safety and compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selected examination of procedures and representative records. The inspection results were discussed with you at the conclusion of the onsite inspection.
