## PROGRAM SCOPE

This facility is authorized and provides radio-pharmaceuticals for diagnostic and therapeutic procedures and quality control sources to Part 35 licensees. The hours of operation are 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. The first and second run for licensees serviced by this facility are prepared and sent from the Richmond, VA facility. The Virginia Beach facility prepares approximately 30 to 35 doses per day for the third run. There is one Registered Pharmacist, one secretary and five technicians/drivers. This facility does not prepare, but passes through I-131 doses. The technicians/drivers perform package surveys upon distribution and receipt.

There is one hood/drawing station and the pharmacy has not prepared I-131 doses for their customers since January 8, 2002. This pharmacy obtains Tc-99m from three generators, two used by the Richmond facility and one new 24 curie generator. The pharmacy receives the generators during the second week following calibration. The Virginia Beach drivers meet the Richmond drivers and transfer the generators and doses and transport them to the Virginia Beach facility and to customers in North Carolina, respectively. The Richmond drivers deliver doses to customers in Williamsburg, Hampton, Portsmouth and Newport News area for the first and second run.
