PROGRAM SCOPE

Inspector arrived onsite at rear door around 0700, in time for the second run which began about 0800 (first run started around 0400). Returns began to arrive about 0800 as well. RCA includes several rooms and lab with hoods. Business has expanded since previous inspection, to include third run.

Facility staff included 4 R.Pharmacists on rotating shifts, 3 techs, and 10 drivers. Colin Laird is facility manager. Corporate audits conducted quarterly, with monthly internal audits performed by Duncansville office staff in rotation. Issues identified by audits were clearly defined with corrective actions described and tracked. Number of audit items trended downward for period reviewed (June to Sept.).

Office manager reported Cardinal Health corporate planned to close the CA office and move pharmacy operations office and staff to Dublin, OH.

Reviewed monthly whole body and extremity monitoring records, area monitoring, and periodic surveys.
