PROGRAM SCOPE

This facility is authorized and provides radio-pharmaceuticals for diagnostic and therapeutic procedures and quality control sources to Part 35 licensees. The hours of operation are from about 12:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. This facility supplies the first and second run for licensees serviced by the Virginia Beach facility. The Richmond facility prepares approximately 480 to 550 doses per day for three runs. There are six Registered Pharmacists, two secretaries, one Virginia certified technician and one technician-in-training. The facility employs approximately 25 drivers. This facility prepares I-131 doses for therapeutic procedures. The technicians/drivers perform package surveys upon distribution and receipt.

There are three hood/drawing stations and the pharmacy routinely prepares I-131 doses for their customers. This pharmacy obtains Tc-99m from six generators, two of which are used by the Virginia Beach facility after the first week in the Richmond facility. The Virginia Beach drivers meet the Richmond drivers and transfer the generators and some doses then transport the remaining doses to customers in the Virginia Beach, Norfolk area for the first and second run.

Corporate audits the program at least twice a year and their rating has been "excellent" over the last three audits.
