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### OCRWM LSN Strategic Approach \*

- Three-fold approach to complying with the NRC Rule:
  1. Identify NRC's LSN Requirements (10 CFR Part 2, Subpart J) for DOE.
  2. Summarize Regulatory, Management, Policy, and Information Management issues.
  3. Defines DOE Management Strategy to meet the NRC's requirements.

\* NOTE: The OCRWM LSN Strategic Approach is a draft document.

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## DOCUMENTARY MATERIAL

Is defined as:

1. Any information upon which DOE intends to rely and/or cite in support of its license application;
2. Any information that is known to, and in the possession of or developed by DOE that is relevant to, but does not support, its license application; and,
3. All reports and studies, prepared by or on behalf of DOE, including all related "circulated drafts" relevant to both the license application and the Topical Guidelines.

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## DOCUMENT COLLECTION

Estimated current universe of documents to be screened for documentary material:

Approximately 6,000,000 Documents consisting of:

- Approximately 5,000,000 E-Mail files with attachments;
- Approximately 1,000,000 records in the OCRWM Records Management System (11.6M Pages); and
- Copyrighted materials used as references.

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## CERTIFICATION

- Six months prior to submitting a License Application, DOE must certify that documentary material has been made available electronically.
  - To provide this certification, DOE must establish and implement procedures to identify documentary material and to provide it in the required electronic format.
- DOE must update the certification at the time DOE submits the License Application.
- YMSCO Project Manager will be the DOE LSN Certification Official.

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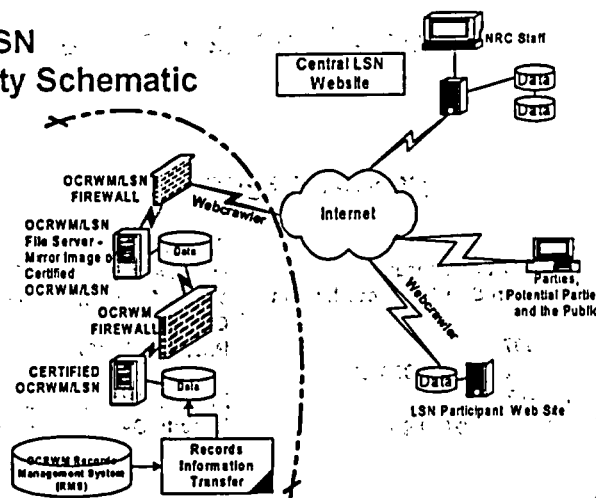
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## OCRWM/LSN Connectivity Schematic
