## OCRWM LSN Strategic Approach \*


- Three-fold approach to complying with the NRC Control of Borrell Description

- Any information that is known to, and in the possession of or developed by DOE that is relevant to, but does not support, its license application; and,
- 3. All reports and studies, prepared by or on behalf of DOE, including all related "circulated drafts" relevant to both the license application and the Topical Guidelines.

Approximately 6,000,000 Documents consisting of:


- Approximately 5,000,000 E-Mail files with attachments;






### CERTIFICATION

- Six months prior to submitting a License Application, DOE must certify that documentary material has been made available electronically.
  - To provide this certification, DOE must establish and implement procedures to identify documentary material and to provide it in the required electronic format.
- DOE must update the certification at the time DOE submits the License Application.
- YMSCO Project Manager will be the DOE LSN Certification Official.
