<b>Subject:</b> Failure to submit a renewal application or terminate the license.		
<p><u>Summary:</u> Mr. Kelley called to inform me that he had received the letter informing them that the license had expired. He stated that it was their intention to keep the gas chromatograph in storage until such time as they hire a person to use the unit. Once that is done, they intended to renew the license. I told Mr. Kelley that if the ECD in the gas chromatograph was specifically-licensed, then the licensee would need to send in a request for a new license. Since they possessed the unit, it did not matter whether the unit was in storage or in use. A license would be needed and a fee would need to be paid. If, however, the unit was generally-licensed, then the license could be retired and a new license application would not have to be submitted. I informed Mr. Kelley where to look and determine whether the gauge was generally or specifically-licensed. Mr. Kelley agreed to call me back.</p> <p>11:15 Mr. Kelley described the tag that he found attached to the ECD of the gas chromatograph. I agreed with him that the unit was a generally-licensed item. I informed him that he should make a photocopy of the tag and send in a cover letter. The cover letter should state that the license has expired and that the NRC should retire the license based on the fact that they do not have any licensed material for which the license was issued. I also informed Mr. Kelley that the regulations concerning generally-licensed items are found in 10 CFR 31.5 and advised him of how to access a copy of the regulations should he not have a copy.</p>
