- NRC provided guidance on the need to retrieve NEF Emergency Plans from the public
- LES is ready to discuss construction and readiness review inspection planning

Status/Schedule Adherence



- Extended comment period for the draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) ended on January 7, 2005
 - Impact on issuance of final EIS
- Additional information supporting LES safe-by-design information was submitted on November 30, 2004 and December 10, 2004
- Response to Request for Additional Information (RAI) on decommissioning funding was submitted December 10, 2004 and January 7, 2005
- Response to chemical exposure limits conference call questions was submitted on December 22, 2004

Status/Schedule



Adherence(continued)

- Response to instrumentation and controls conference call questions was submitted October 28, 2004
- Response to conference call questions regarding worker safety during a seismic event was submitted on December 22, 2004
- A meeting among NRC, DOE, and LES on Foreign-Ownership, Control or Influence (FOCI) was held on November 10, 2004; a letter from DOE is forthcoming
- A draft Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) for treatment of cultural sites was issued for a 30-day comment period on November 2, 2004

- Minor Security Plan comments to be addressed in upcoming submittal
- LES is screening its submittals for sensitive information using the NRC Staff Review Criteria to Identify Sensitive Information in Fuel Cycle Documents, dated December 21, 2004

- NRC inspection / audit of the implementation of the LES Quality Assurance Program to be scheduled
- Impact of NRC document review/redaction on schedule/ Safety Evaluation Report issuance

Architect / Engineer

- LES and Shaw Group announced the agreement for Shaw to provide A/E services to LES on January 7, 2005
- Work with Shaw has already begun
- Expect to maintain construction readiness schedule
