- 2.2. Survey Results,
- 2.3. Licensee Events Reports (LER) including LER's 82-045 and 82-016,
- 2.4. Follow-up Inspections with the licensee and the Fort Pierce Sewage Treatment Plant.

#3- Please include all analysis related to radiological surveys, quantification and identification of isotopes released from the plant from the time of initial criticality 1976 until the release path was terminated in 1982 conducted by:

- 3.1. the licensee,
- 3.2. the NRC,
- 3.3. EPA,

Nuclear Regulatory Commission

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- 3.4. The State of Florida,
- 3.5. and any other Federal or State Agencies,
- 3.6. and/or Contractors.

#4- Please include all calculations and assessments related to the residual isotopic activity remaining at the disposal sites.

#5- Please provide all documents and notes pertaining to the disposal and/or removal of sludge from the Fort Pierce Sewage Treatment Plant including the location and analysis of any and all areas used by the Fort Pierce Sewage Treatment Plant for disposal of its sludge from 1976 to 1985.

#6- Where did St. Lucie Units 1 and 2 dispose of any radioactive water and what was recorded environmental input and impact from 1976 to 1985?

#7- Where did the Fort Pierce Sewage Treatment Plant dispose of any radioactive water and what was recorded environmental input and impact from 1976 to 1985?


#8- Please provide a list of all documents and all information contained therein pertaining to the present day land use of any and all areas used for the sludge disposal by the Fort Pierce Sewage Treatment facility for the disposal of sludge originating at the St. Lucie Units 1 and 2 from 1976 to present.

#9- Please provide estimates of the total volume of all discharges and estimates of the radioactivity discharge by each particular isotope for the entire period.
