Dear Ms. Gaskins:

In response to the letter dated December 14, 2004 regarding the amendment request dated October 13, 2004, Cardinal Health requests that requirements for a decommission survey for the restricted portion at 713-B Harris Street, Charlottesville, Virginia that will become unrestricted office space be deferred until after the remodel has been approved and completed. This area currently houses the generators and biohazard hood for handling of radioactive material for sterile labeling of blood cell components. There is no room in the current restricted area that can adequately house the hood without compromising sterility, nor is there room in the current restricted area for the generators. The remodel will need to be approved and completed so that these items may be moved to the areas where they will be located, and then a decommission survey can be made on the now empty area.

Cardinal Health confirms that it will treat the area formerly used as a restricted area until a decommission survey can be made, and a report is filed. After approval by the Department, the area will then be released for unrestricted use.
