In SMUD letter MPC&D 04-074, dated September 7, 2004, we provided you with our response to the NRC Order issued on August 18, 2004, regarding additional security measures associated with access authorization at the Rancho Seco Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation (ISFSI). In our response we stated that we have begun implementation of the requirements and will complete implementation within 180 days from the date of the Order.
