This letter provides an update to information provided in Entergy's letter to NRC, dated October 4, 2004 (Reference a). In Reference (a), it was noted that an existing volume of soil piles was located between the Vermont Yankee Nuclear Power Station cooling towers. Subsequent to that submittal, because of temporary traffic routing due to parking lot modifications and cooling tower upgrade work, the soil piles were relocated to a location on the north side of the site. The location of these soil piles has no impact on our spreading request, or its basis.
