11. The Radiation Safety Officer (RSO) for this license is 1Lt. Harry M. Stewart, Jr.
12. The licensee's Radiation Safety Committee may permit any physician to use byproduct material for medical use. The physician must meet the appropriate training and experience criteria in 10 CFR Part 35, Subpart J.

Approvals of individuals so designated shall be supported by records maintained by the RSO.

13. In addition to the possession limits in item 10, the licensee shall further restrict the possession of licensed material to quantities below the minimum limit specified in 10 CFR 30.35 for establishing decommissioning financial assurance.
14. Except as specifically provided otherwise in this license, the licensee shall conduct its program in accordance with the statements, representations, and procedures contained in the documents, including any enclosures, listed below, except for minor changes in the medical use radiation safety procedures as provided in 10 CFR 35.31. The U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's regulations shall govern unless the statements, representations, and procedures in the licensee's application and correspondence are more restrictive than the regulations.


