Prior to release of your current facility for unrestricted use, you must receive an Amendment removing your current facility from your license. Include in the request, the results of surveys demonstrating that the levels of residual activity in the facility are acceptable. When you submit the Amendment request, please refer to the Control Number at the top of this letter.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand and fully implement all the conditions incorporated into the amended license. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region I Office, Licensing Assistance Team, (610) 337-5239, so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

An environmental assessment for this action is not required, since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(14).

Please note that on October 25, 2004, the NRC suspended public access to ADAMS, and initiated an additional security review of publicly available documents to ensure that potentially sensitive information is removed from the ADAMS database accessible through the NRC's web site.
