Pursuant to the federal Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. 552, I request access to and copies of all documents regarding Ann M. Lovell, including cases PH-1221-97-0349-W1 & PH-1221-97-0218-W1.

Include information contained in the material that otherwise would be considered non-responsive to this specific request, and let me know of similar requests.

Please justify each deletion separately by reference to specific exemptions of the Act, and release all reasonably segregable portions of otherwise exempt material. I, of course, reserve the right to appeal any decisions.

Notify me prior to incurring more than \$100 of expenses. The information I seek is intended for a newspaper series that, as the fee waiver requires, is "likely to contribute significantly to public understanding of the operations or activities of the government." Several multi-part projects I have written about government operations were distributed by Cox to its own newspapers and to papers serviced by its wire operation. Those same projects resulted in network news magazine shows on ABC, NBC, CBS and cable networks, Congressional hearings, federal legislation, policy changes and numerous national awards—including three presented personally by Presidents Clinton, Ford and George W. Bush. I ask that you waive all fees.

This information is of timely value, so please communicate questions by telephone rather than by mail. I look forward to your reply within 20 business days, as the statute requires.
