Dear Administrative Judges:

I wish to advise the Board and counsel for the parties that NIRS/PC mistakenly copied the unredacted versions of four documents that have been marked as exhibits. We apologize for this error. NIRS/PC requests that recipients please delete the sensitive portions of the following items. The deletions to be made are as follows; replacement pages are included:

1. NIRS/PC Exhibit 14, NEF wall map, extracted from the LES application and downloaded from the Commission Internet system before it was suspended, appears to be unavailable now and we infer that it has been deemed sensitive. Therefore, this one-page exhibit should be destroyed. We anticipate that the parties will need to revise their evidentiary submissions pursuant to the Licensing Board's Memorandum and Order dated January 18, 2005 (Regarding Exhibit Submission and Other Administrative Matters) and propose to mark and submit this exhibit again at that time with appropriate confidentiality designation.


2. NIRS/PC Exhibit 16, LES's May 20, 2004 response to a Request for Additional Information, contains sensitive material at pages 43-44. Text under the heading "7) Radiological and/or chemical impacts from potential accidents" should be deleted. In addition, the table under Table ER RAI 2-6.1 should be deleted, and Figure ER RAI 2-1 should be deleted.

3. NIRS/PC Exhibit 26, the Draft Environmental Impact Statement, NUREG-1790, was copied in its unredacted form. Based on the version now posted on the Internet, deletions are as follows: all of pages 4-39 and 4-40, text at 4-47, sec. 4.2.13, all of pages 4-48 and 4-49, Table 4-18 at page 4-58, text at page 4-70 after the first four lines, text on page 4-71 up to line 35, the figure on page 6-1, text at page C-14 following line 16, all of pages C-15 and C-16, all of page C-17 except the first paragraph under C.4.1.3, text on page C-18 under Table C-13, and all of pages C-19 through C-29.

4. NIRS/PC Exhibit 43, the Final Environmental Impact Statement for the Construction and Operation of the Claiborne Enrichment Center, NUREG-1484, was copied in its unredacted form. Based on a redacted version made available by Commission Staff, deletions are as follows: all of page 2-48; all of page 2-49 up to the paragraph beginning "Industrial waste"; all of page 4-46 after the first three lines; all of pages 4-47 through 4-64.

We enclose replacement pages reflecting the deletions (except where entire pages are deleted). We regret the problem created by this inadvertence and hope that these replacement pages can be integrated without great difficulty.
