Dr. Myron was unaware that he was listed as the RSO on this license. He was the RSO for Gammapar, but was terminated on 1/7/05.

When I explained to Dr. Myron that the survey dated 11/9/04 was not complete (no survey for alpha contamination), he understood and committed to looking into this matter. He said that he would get back to me by 2/10/05.

I explained that our last inspector noted that their customer would survey for gamma and alpha contamination prior to sending the sample for analysis to Central Virginia Labs. I told Dr. Myron if he could find those records, they may show that the Virginia Beach facility never received radioactive samples.

Dr. Myron thanked me for the call.
