**Upgrading the Design Basis Threat Regulations  
for Protection Against Terrorist Attacks on Nuclear Reactors**

We are a non-governmental organisation in opposition to the nuclear power stations on the East Anglian coast of the United Kingdom. Because the consequences of nuclear incidents can be world-wide, we wish to comment on the above-mentioned petition submitted to you by the Committee to Bridge the Gap.

While we appreciate and respect the thinking behind the Committee's petition, we hold to the view that the dangers of reactors are so serious that the only appropriate solution is to close all of them down at once and to remove their fuel.

To demonstrate a stubborn determination to protect them intact and in operation against determined attack would give the wrong message, for they are themselves inherently inimical to life.

In view of the international impasse reached over the obligations of the Nuclear Non-Proliferation Treaty, the step we advocate also presents the only remaining realistic way for the US, UK and others to demonstrate the good faith that is necessary to provide a basis from which to develop international nuclear safety.
