Enclosed is a copy of the "Beaver Valley Unit 1 Cycle 17 Voltage-Based Repair Criteria 90-Day Report," which supports continued implementation of the 2.0 volt repair criteria as outlined in Reference 1. This report provides a summary of the steam generator inspections performed during the sixteenth refueling outage at tube support plate intersections along with postulated steam line break leak rate and tube burst probability analysis results.

In accordance with Beaver Valley Power Station (BVPS) Unit No. 1 Technical Specification 4.4.5.5.e which requires that a Steam Generator Special Report be submitted within 90 days following return of the steam generators to service (Mode 4), Appendix A of the enclosed report provides the aggregate calculated steam line break leakage from the application of tube support plate alternate repair criteria and W* methodology. Appendix A also supplies the identified indications performed as part of the W* inspections.

In accordance with Section 3.1.7 of NEI 97-06, Appendix B of the enclosed report provides a synopsis of the BVPS Unit No. 1 sixteenth refueling (1R16) condition monitoring report due to the steam generator inspection being categorized as C-3.
