<p>Summary:</p> <p>I questioned Dr. Snyder on the previous use of unsealed RAM under this license. He stated that he began working at the school in 1986, and from that time forward, there has been no field or greenhouse studies using unsealed radioactive materials. He stated that he has no knowledge of any such work that was performed, and that the previous RSO's paperwork did not indicate that any such studies were performed. To Dr. Snyder's knowledge, all work with RAM was performed in the labs for which surveys were provided with the termination request. He told me that he would ask some of the other researchers who have been there for a long time if they know of any other locations of use and will call me back early next week.</p>
