SUBJECT: CLOSURE OF INVESTIGATION (OI 4-2004-026)

Dear Mr. Arveson:

This refers to an investigation conducted by the NRC Office of Investigations (OI) regarding activities of Kakivik Asset Management. OI initiated the investigation to determine whether a former radiographer was subjected to employment discrimination for having raised safety concerns regarding the use of radioactive materials.

Based on the evidence developed during the investigation, testimony, and document reviews, the allegation was not substantiated. The NRC plans no further action related to willful misconduct and considers this investigation closed.
