John, a legal secretary with Duke counsel's law firm,

¹We note that Appendix A to the Protective Order, a Nondisclosure Affidavit to be signed by all persons covered by the Order (a copy of which Ms. John has signed), itself provides that persons covered by the order, including Duke counsel, agree that any secretarial or administrative work will be performed only by personnel authorized pursuant to paragraph B of the Protective Order, which provides that any such person will have completed a "trustworthiness review[] satisfactory to the NRC Staff." We accept from NRC Staff counsel's agreement to this amendment that the Staff has determined that Duke's "procedures to receive access to Safeguards Information," put forth by Duke counsel as the procedures under which Ms. John's trustworthiness has been determined, are equivalent to those of the Staff, as required in the Protective Order. Should this not be the case, we expect that the Staff will see that any necessary additional measures to assure such trustworthiness are taken.
