This letter is to provide supplemental information to our request previously submitted, dated December 7, 2004. In addition to our request for an amendment to the above license to add an authorized user, we provided a diagram of a new cardiac scan room and injection area located adjacent to the stress lab and outpatient waiting area.

We verify our procedure for transporting our doses to the injection room will adhere to the following procedure:

- 1) All radioactive syringes will be enclosed in a syringe shield.
- 2) The dose will be transported in a lead pig from the Hot Lab to the injection room so as to minimize exposure to the technologist and the general public.
- 3) The used syringe will be transported back to the Hot Lab in a lead pig for disposal.
