I briefly looked over the letter and noted some additional information is needed as follows:

1. Our current policy for removing items from the license is to request disposition records for those items being removed. Please provide a copy of the receipt paperwork for the sources that have been disposed or returned to the supplier.
2. Your request for decay in storage of 300 day half life material will need significant justification and what you have provided is unclear. Such requests are normally sent to our Headquarters Office for their review and approval. If you want to pursue this authorization please provide additional justification.
3. In looking at your current DFP I noted you indicate an adjustment to the cost estimate will be done every 10 years or at license renewal but the regulations indicate ( 10 CFR 30.35 (e)) this should be done at least every 3 years. Please confirm you intend to do this.
