At the conclusion of the inspection, an exit briefing to discuss the inspection findings was conducted with you and Messrs. Brambaugh and Beghtol of your staff.

Within the scope of this inspection, no violations were identified; therefore, no response to this letter or the enclosed NRC Form 591M is required.
